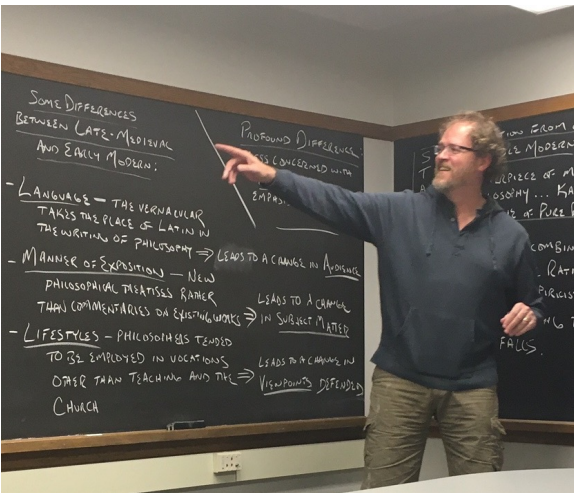

Only papers written by undergraduate students will be accepted. **Submission deadline is February 12, 2017.** All papers are subject to blind review. Include detachable title page with name, title, and institution. The paper itself should include the paper title and a short abstract but no name or name of institution. Submit papers as attachments in pdf/word.doc format to Andrew Spear at: speara@gvsu.edu

Papers should be prepared to be read within 30-40- minutes. Each paper will be assigned a student commentator.
