CLINICAL SUMMARY

Type of Gestation: Singleton
 Intrauterine pregnancy in vertex presentation.
 Fetal size is decreased for gestational age by weight.

Fetal growth:

Decreased fetal growth from previous study

Fetal motion and organs seen:

- A fetal bladder was observed
- A fetal stomach was observed
- A four chamber cardiac view was observed

Fetal abnormalities observed:

- Fetal gender: Male
- Placental location: Anterior.
- Placental maturity was Grade II.
- There is no evidence of placenta previa.
- Amniotic fluid volume is decreased.
- The nuchal translucency was greater than 2.0 mm.
- There was not funnelling of the internal os.
- Uterus and adnexae: No abnormalities seen
